

Easy Peasy Mouse Mat Cover

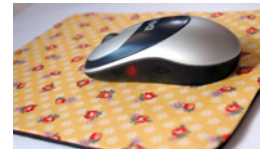


Materials

- Mouse Mat
- Small Piece of Iron-On Interfacing
- Small Piece of Fabric
- Craft Glue



1 Trace the shape of the mousemat onto the interfacing. Cut your fabric about an inch larger on all sides.



Mouse Mat, Steps 2 to 5



2 With the right side of the fabric down, centre the interfacing and iron it down. Make sure it attaches securely over the entire surface.



3 Trim the fabric around the interfacing, leaving about 1.5cm all around. Clip around the curves, stopping a couple of millimetres from the interfacing.



4 Fold the edges over and glue in place. Take care around the corners, as they can become bulky.



5 Spread a thin layer of glue over the top of the mouse mat. Lay the cover on top, press down, and you're finished!

Note: You don't need to start with an existing mouse mat. Use a thick piece of felt in its place, and create any size or shape you want!

Another note: My favourite craft glue is Aleene's Tacky Glue. I've been using it forever — it's inexpensive and a little goes a long way. Always spread a very thin layer when using it with fabric, so it doesn't bleed through or cause lumps.
